- Ash : 0.05% max. by weight on dry basis.
- Carbon : 0.05% max. by weight on dry basis.
- As : 0.25 ppm max. by weight on dry basis.
- Se : 1.00 ppm max. by weight on dry basis.
- Te : 1.00 ppm max. by weight on dry basis.
- Acidity : 0.02% max. by weight on dry basis.
- Chlorides : 50 ppm max. by weight on dry basis.
- Moisture : Not to exceed 3% by weight on wet basis.

MOISTURE IN EXCESS OF 0.5% DETERMINED AT LOAD PORT SHALL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE BILL OF LADING WEIGHT AND THE NET WEIGHT SO ARRIVED AT SHALL BE INVOICED.
